By choosing a charity and using either the GoodSearch toolbar or going to www.goodsearch.com you'll earn a percentage of your purchases toward donations for BIAF. iGive also helps you donate to BIAF by shopping. You can download their [iGive Button](#) to help us not only earn donations based on a percentage of your shopping, but a \$5 bonus for every person who installs the iGive button and keeps it installed for 30 days.

Buying or selling on E-bay can also help BIAF. Brain Injury Association of Florida is one of the charities available to donate to using Mission Fish. You can choose to donate a portion of any item you sell or add a little something to any auction you win to BIAF using Mission Fish.
